

## **2017/18**

For the 2017 / 18 financial year the school's allocation of Pupil Premium was **£97,520**, an £8,000 increase from 2016 / 17 due to increasing children eligible for Pupil Premium funding. The funding has and will continue to be spent to support 'Vulnerable / Pupil Premium' pupils to achieve the very best they can. Money has been spent in the following ways:

- **£44,850** - Teacher employed 4 days a week throughout the 2017 / 18 academic year to teach targeted personalised Literacy and Maths interventions to accelerate the progress of Pupil Premium pupils.
- **£19,500** - Targeted interventions by teaching assistants to support and accelerate the progress of Pupil Premium pupils.
- **£8,500** - Funding to allow Pupil Premium pupils to attend extra-curricular clubs, breakfast and after school clubs, holiday clubs, go on school visits, have music tuition, uniform and PE kits.
- **£3,500** - Booster revision classes run prior to school, after school and in school time for targeted Pupil Premium pupils in Y6 in Reading, Writing, SPAG and Mathematics.
- **£1,500** - Targeted support from a Home School Worker for Vulnerable / Pupil Premium pupils.
- **£3,000** - Targeted speech and language therapy support for Vulnerable / Pupil Premium pupils.
- **£8,250** - For learning resources to facilitate Pupil Premium pupils progress e.g. new iPads, new apps, new reading books, SENs resources.
- **£8,420** - SENCo and teaching assistant support for Pupil Premium / Vulnerable pupils to accelerate their progress in Phonics, Reading, Reading Comprehension, Writing and Mathematics in EYFS, KS1 and KS2.
