For the 2021/22 financial year, the school allocation of Pupil Premium funding is £59,180; a decrease of £22,865 from 2020/21. The funding has and will continue to support 'Vulnerable/Pupil Premium' pupils to achieve the very best they can.

The funding has been committed in the following ways:
